Hello to God's beloved ones! We hope that your new year has had a good start and that you are experiencing God's kindnesses as He daily loads us with blessings. Here is an update on how good the Lord has been to us and the upcoming plans.



In just a few weeks, we will be heading over to Slovenia for our second trip there. We will be leaving on March 6th and returning on March 23rd. That will be two full weeks and three Sundays. We are hoping to minister in the churches on those three Sundays to reach many Slovenians. During the week, we will be going to many different home groups throughout the country and teaching the Word of God. On this trip, we are going to spread out and cover more of the country, from east to west, from the coastline to the mountains to the lower hills.

We have it strong in our hearts to reach the key Christian leaders in each of the main cities so that we will be able to reach their whole nation for Jesus. There are approximately 2.5 million people in Slovenia. About half of them are Catholic seeing how the country borders Italy.

Besides just teaching the Word, we greatly desire that the Slovenians experience the touch of God and the moving of the Holy Spirit. Their culture is steeped in traditional Catholicism and just plain secularism, so the majority of them have never known the Lord personally and up close. But they are very hungry for it!

During this trip, I really have it in my heart to stir up the believers to have weekly prayer meetings so that, as they pray in the Spirit, God will be able to do mightier things there. We will definitely minister to the sick, also, since that is such a passion of ours.

Concerning the finances for this trip, we already have our plane tickets paid for! Praise God! We are still believing God for about \$2000 for the other expenses for the trip. And God is faithful! We want to be a blessing to the Slovenians and not put any of the expenses on them. Perhaps we can bless them real good financially before we leave, too. Grega will be driving us all around the country, so we want to pay for his gas. And we want to bless Klemen, the pastor of two churches, who is working to make ends meet.

Over 22 years ago, Dan was asking God what his ministry was supposed to be. He asked, "Am I an apostle, a prophet, an evangelist, a pastor, or a teacher?" The Lord supernaturally told Dan, "2 Chronicles 11:11," so he went to his Bible and looked it up.

And he fortified the strongholds, and put captains in them, and stores of food, oil, and wine. (2 Chronicles 11:11 NKJV)

Dan knew right then that he was called to establish and strengthen churches, their pastors and their leaders. Food, oil, and wine are symbolic of the Word, healing anointing, and the Holy Spirit.

Years ago, the Lord had given me a simple, two-word mandate to, "Train worshippers."

So, the Lord has taken us through much spiritual training and extensive preparation, but we are finally beginning to step into what we were called before birth to do.
