Hello Beloved,

It has been a month since we returned to Florida from the Balkans. We had an amazing five months ministering in six countries. I know that many of you have been following us on Facebook, but we want to give you a summary of the trip and an update of what is happening next.



From mid-April to the second week of September, we were in Slovenia, Serbia, Montenegro, Macedonia, Kosovo, and Turkey. This was our very first time in Montenegro and Kosovo. God was leading us throughout the entire journey. From the day we left until the day we returned, God directed our steps and opened doors.

Some of the highlights from our trip

- ✈️ There were zero problems traveling. We crossed every border without incident.
- ✈️ We met with 12 pastors and their families that we had never met before.
- ✈️ Strengthening our friendships with all of the other pastors and missionaries we've already met was our number one mission and we were very successful.
- ✈️ People accepted Jesus, received the baptism of the Holy Spirit, and got healed.
- ✈️ Several reported to us that they were doing what we had preached the last few trips and were blessed because they saw it working in their lives.
- ✈️ Our financial support of the pastors and ministries increased. We were able to put some cash into all of the pastors' hands.
- ✈️ We were also able to provide a cell phone and new van for one of the missionaries (With your help!), restructure the whole stage and sound system for a church, buy a washer & dryer for homeless ministry, help provide firewood for needy families, and give toward the costs of the conference in Turkey.



We accomplished A LOT on this trip:

We had 42 church meetings, 20 home groups, 52 get-togethers, 10 prayer meetings, several Zoom meetings, three conferences, and served a ladies camp by cooking and cleaning. We also went street-witnessing with tracks that we helped design and print.

Our adventure included 13 flights, 12 car reservations, 6 apartments, 4 hotels, 3 homes, and a hostel.

We drove thousands of miles, packed and unpacked a lot, had some crazy moments, met amazing people, and made some wonderful friendships.



On July 25 of this year, Rachel and I (Veronica) were reading about a man's account of heaven and also hell. When he said that there were giant pits in hell for whole nations, it gripped my heart so deeply that I couldn't continue reading.

The nations we've been working in are "unreached," which means less than 1% are born-again. It moved my heart to think that all of Slovenia, Serbia, Turkey, and the other countries of the world would go to hell. We love these people in the Balkans and want to see them in heaven.



The people of the Balkans are under socialism and corrupt governments; they only have cold, dead religions (Islam, Catholicism, Orthodoxy, and Atheism).

Because of their hopelessness and poverty, there is a lot of depression and suicide. Many of them are into drugs, alcohol, and gambling.

When the youth get old enough, they move away to other places with more opportunity; then the countries are left with even less hope for their future.



Our plan, as of now, is to return to the Balkans next spring and summer, Lord willing. Our burning desire is to take several teams of missionary workers with us.

If the Lord is calling you to help us reach these nations, all you need is faith. If the Lord told you to go, simply obey Him and He will be the "Waymaker," and the Provider of all that you need.


